Sarah always loved chocolate. The rich, sweet taste always brought her joy. She dreamed of sharing this joy with others. With her family's encouragement, she decided (1)open her own chocolate shop, "Sarah's Sweets," in her hometown. Her shop quickly became popular because of its delicious and unique chocolate creations.

One sunny afternoon, [ A ] enjoying her coffee during her break time, Sarah came across an article online. Her eyes widened in shock. The article was about the dark side of chocolate production, involving child labor in cocoa-producing countries. She realized that cocoa, the main ingredient in chocolate, is mostly grown in countries in West Africa, such as Côte d'Ivoire and Ghana. Many children are forced to do hard and dangerous tasks, risking their health and safety. (2) She couldn't believe that something she loved so much could have such a negative reality.

Sarah read about a boy named Kofi from Côte d'Ivoire. Kofi was only ten years old but had already spent several years working on a cocoa farm. His day started very early in the morning before [ B ] and he worked until dark, carrying heavy sacks of cocoa beans and using a large knife to clear the fields. Kofi dreamed of going to school and becoming a teacher, but (3) seem impossible.

Sarah decided to change the way she ran her chocolate shop. While researching on the Internet, she learned of efforts by the International Labour Organization (ILO) and various non-governmental organizations (NGOs). These groups were providing scholarships and promoting fair trade practices so that farmers could receive a fair price for their cocoa.

Inspired by what she learned, Sarah decided to only use fair trade cocoa for her chocolates. She learned that fair trade ensures the farmers will be paid fairly and that no child labor will be used. [ C ] this change meant higher costs, she believed it was the right thing to do.

Sarah also began raising awareness of the importance of fair trade cocoa among her customers by sharing Kofi's life story. She organized events in her shop, [ D ] experts of fair trade products. To her delight, many of her customers willingly supported her efforts.

[ E ] she stood in her shop, watching customers enjoy her chocolates, Sarah recognized she was helping people realize the importance of fair trade cocoa. "Sarah's Sweets" was not just providing delicious treats; it was making a difference, one

chocolate at a time. She was very happy because she had found a deeper and sweeter purpose for selling her chocolate.

Technology has greatly changed the way education is delivered in universities worldwide. In Japan, new tools like learning management systems (LMS), e-books, and online resources have made it easier for students to access information and learning materials. This shift to digital education creates a more flexible and adaptable learning environment, [ A ] students can study remotely or on campus, accessing a wide range of resources at any time that suits their schedules.

Interactive technologies called virtual reality (VR) and augmented reality (AR) are also changing traditional learning methods, especially in fields like medicine and engineering. For example, medical students can use VR to practice virtual surgeries in 3D, [B] makes complex concepts easier to understand and visualize. Engineering students can design and test structures in a virtual space, which allows them to experiment with various scenarios and designs without real-world risks. These interactive technologies not only improve the learning experience but also make learning more engaging and practical.

Additionally, online collaboration tools are [ C ] for students' communication and groupwork. Tools like video conferencing, discussion forums, and collaborative document editing have made it easier for students to work on group projects, attend virtual lectures, and participate in discussions whether they are at school or at home. (1) This has been especially useful in emergencies. While the COVID-19 pandemic was prevailing, this technology ensured continuous education.

However, the rapid integration of technology in education also brings a challenge; the inability to provide equal access to these resources. This challenge, called the digital divide, remains (2) a major issue as not all students have the same access to necessary technology, such as computers or reliable internet connections. Universities must address this gap by providing equipment and internet access for every student who lacks these essential resources. [ D ], there is a need for training both students and faculty to effectively use these new tools to their full potential, ensuring that everyone can benefit from these technological advancements.

The growth of digital platforms also brings up worries about data security and

privacy, leading universities to put in place strong cybersecurity measures. Protecting students' [E] information and ensuring secure access to educational resources are crucial tasks for modern educational institutions. Universities are putting in advanced security systems and educating their members about the best practices for digital security. Despite these challenges, one benefit of technology in education is clear: it can provide an enriched
