In recent years, journaling has become a popular way for people to take care of their mental health. Journaling means writing down your thoughts, feelings, or experiences in a notebook or on a computer. It may seem like a simple activity,



[A] many studies have shown that journaling has real mental health benefits. One important benefit of journaling is stress reduction. According to researchers, writing about your emotions can help calm the mind. It gives people a chance to release negative thoughts and understand [B] is bothering them. For students, this can be helpful during exam season or when they feel pressure from school or relationships.

Journaling can also improve mood and emotional awareness. By writing about daily experiences, people start to notice patterns in their feelings. For example, someone might realize they always feel anxious after staying up late or skipping meals. This self-understanding can help people make small changes that lead to a healthier lifestyle. ⁽¹⁾This is considered one of the key mental health benefits of journaling.

There are many different styles of journaling. Some people use a “gratitude journal” to write about things they are thankful for each day. This helps them focus on the positive parts of life, even during hard times. Others use “bullet journaling” to organize tasks, track habits, and reflect on goals. Another method is “free writing.” In this style, people write anything that comes to mind without worrying about grammar or structure. [C], it allows full expression without strict rules. ⁽²⁾These styles make journaling a flexible and personal activity.

[D] journaling is also known to improve focus and memory. When people write down their thoughts, they often gain clarity and feel more in control. It can be especially helpful for those who find it hard to talk about their emotions out loud. Writing privately gives them a safe space to express their feelings honestly. In Japan, more schools and counselors are recommending journaling as a healthy habit. It is quiet, low-cost, and easy to begin. Many students say it helps them manage stress and feel more relaxed after writing for just ten minutes a day. ⁽³⁾This is one reason why journaling is becoming more popular among students.

[E], journaling is not a cure for all problems, but it can be a useful tool for self-care. Whether writing about worries, future dreams, or daily routines, journaling helps people better understand themselves and take care of their emotional well-being—one page at a time.

I studied abroad in Indonesia for a year in college. I was a little nervous at first, [A] from my first week there, everyone was really welcoming. On my first day at the campus cafeteria, I ordered Indonesian fried rice [B] *nasi goreng*, which has an egg on top and fried onions. It tasted simple but great. In the evenings, my friends and I often bought *sate taichan* from a small food cart near the campus gate. The cook grilled chicken over hot coals, then added a drop of lime and a mild chili dip. It was so tasty that we shared our food and passed the plates around.

Another interesting part of Indonesian culture is *gotong royong*. It means being kind, helping one another and working together. I noticed it often in small, everyday moments. For example, one rainy day, I forgot my umbrella but a woman whom I did not know let me share hers [C] the storm passed. Another example was one time, at a small local café, the owner poured me a cup of hot coffee, then gave me a refill for free. These acts were simple, but they (1) make my days more relaxed.

[D] public places, people were caring, too. One day on a crowded bus, I saw a woman stand up and give her seat to a small child with a friendly smile. On Sunday mornings in central Jakarta, the city closes some main roads for a car-free day. I often saw small children on kick scooters, [E] many adults enjoyed jogging there.

School and community events also welcomed international students like me. We learned easy traditional dance steps, sang local songs, and made small crafts with local children. In addition, many Indonesians are Muslims, so during Ramadan — a holy month when Muslims do not eat during the day — (2) people look forward to the evening meal. After sunset, neighbors bring plates of food to share. They pass around dates* and warm soup, and they sit together and talk for a long time. One evening during Ramadan, after we broke the fast** with my friend's family, we went to a big shopping mall. The shops were open late, and the air was cool. Families walked slowly, children played in a clean play area, and parents pushed strollers along wide corridors. We listened to live music on a small stage, and later we drank fresh mango juice at the food court.



When we left the mall, we saw a new train station, and new buildings being constructed. Indonesia is growing fast, and many people around the world are becoming more interested in it now. That night I thought, “(3) _____”. It's starting to feel like my second home.”
